

# CONTINUE YOUR EDUCATION

**Now that you've finished the Basic course at Aventura, promote yourself to a higher grade! \*** Aventura offers many more courses to add to your sailing skills and pleasure. See descriptions below. A price list with dates is available in the office. Other seminars and lectures are also provided through the club and are listed below at the end of the regular classes. Watch for special offerings and view the calendar of upcoming events in The Aventura Newsletter, as well as on the Aventura WEB site, [www.aventurasailing.com](http://www.aventurasailing.com).

**Basic labs:** You may take the sailing, docking or anchoring labs separately as part of the basic course for \$45 each. This is a great refresher if you are "rusty" and also qualifies for recertification if you have not skippered recently.

**Lectures are free for alumni:** If you are an alumni of a particular class, you are welcome to sit in on lectures to review your knowledge.

**Advanced/Intermediate Certification:** After five charters on basic level boats, you are eligible for upgrade to larger boats. While you may take the course at any time, you will get more out of it if you have a charter or two under your belt. The class consists of four lectures and four labs -- 24 hours of instruction split equally between classroom and on the water sessions. You will learn advanced sailing techniques, sail shape and trim, docking, mooring and anchoring procedures, night navigation, marine electronics, heavy weather seamanship and use of the sextant in navigation. Then after the required charters and passing a written test you will be able to charter up to 36 foot boats. \$200 member, \$250 nonmember.

**Advanced/Intermediate labs:** the A/I labs may be taken separately as Clinics for \$50 each. This is a good way to review your skills on the subjects taught during the A/I class.

**Mini Courses on various marine topics:** Occasionally there will be classes offered on marine topics such as Weather and Electronic Navigation. These are offered on three evenings and cost \$100 for the series.

**Super Boat Certification:** After ten charters on Intermediate to Advanced boats, you are eligible to apply for the Super Boat level that will allow you to charter even larger boats. You must complete a special checkout prior to chartering each different vessel in this category. There is no charge for this certification or the vessel checkout.

**Navigation & Coastal Piloting:** You can get your navigation certification and be eligible to charter overnight trips by attending a one-day or a three-session class. You will learn to find your way up and down the coast, through the islands, and into various anchorages and harbors, even if you can't read a road map. You must complete a written and charting test. The test can be take-home. \$100 member, \$125 non-member.

**Navigation Correspondence Course:** This is a proven self-study program based on the instructor's notes from the classroom sessions. It will get you through the navigation exam at your own pace and at any time. \$35 member.

**Please make reservations in advance. There are no pre-requisites.**

**All prices and offerings are subject to change without notice.**

\* The continuation of any certification and your ability to move to a higher level will depend on your seamanship and care of the vessel while you are chartering.

**Private Lessons:** You can take a 3-hour private lesson at any time with a USCG licensed Captain. Arrangements must be made through the office at the convenience of the instructor. \$175-\$200 member, \$225-\$250 **plus boat fee** non-members. (Same price as the class)

**Clinics:** Various clinics are offered on different aspects of sailing, i.e., docking, anchoring, sail trim. Most clinics are on the water. \$50 member, \$60 non-member

**DON'T FORGET!** You can also improve your skills with the following:

**Cruising Catalina Island Seminar:** There's a lot more to Catalina than sitting on an Avalon mooring! Veteran Catalina cruiser, Bill McNeely, will cover all the basics and show you slides of coves where the ferry never goes. An updated version includes twice as many slides as at previous seminars. Get ready for cruising to the Island. Come and learn about the Catalina you want to know! You will receive Two harbor's publication, Boater's Guide to Catalina. An autographed copy of Bill's new book, Cruising Catalina Island, is for sale and available for \$24.95 at the class. \$45 member, \$55 non-member.

**Fleet Cruises:** Join other members of *Aventura* for any of the 3 or 4-day cruises to one of the islands or to another harbor. During the cruise, an experienced member will be the Fleet Leader. This person will provide a free Skipper's meeting with information on safety, sailing skills, anchoring, good seamanship, and events planned at the Island. The Fleet Leader will provide assistance for any problems or questions that occur during your trip. Reservations for boats need to be made early. Cost depends on which boat you charter and food provided at any on-shore picnic.

**Race Program:** Our low-key race program is held every other week—Friday evenings during the summer and Saturdays during the winter. Skippers, boats, and crew are selected anonymously to provide an equal opportunity for all to participate, regardless of their sailing experience. It is a great way for beginners to hone their skills and eventually gain experience to go on to the next level racing. The cost of the boat is shared by those sailing on it. No reservations are required. Your non-member guests may attend.

**Social Sails:** Social sails occur every other Saturday throughout the year. Members and friends meet in the lounge and boats are chartered relative to group size and skipper certification. The cost of the boat is shared by those sailing on it. A call to the office is requested to ensure availability of sufficient boats.

**Volunteering:** This is another area where you can do some networking by becoming more involved with fellow members at various activities both in *Aventura* and with other associated organizations. Become a leader, gain respect, and share the pride of helping other people realize their dreams.
