RACING PROGRAM • 2021 SPRING SCHEDULE & OVERVIEW

Sailors who want to learn the art of racing, leading to a race skipper or a tactician role will usually start with the Introduction to Racing clinic unless they have previous racing experience. A racing resume allows members to “Challenge” a Clinic to achieve their qualifications. The three main clinics are aimed at Non-Spinnaker racing certification. Spinnaker racing certification is offered as optional follow-on clinics.

Your Recreational Racing Education, Certification & Experience Journey

Aventura Racing is a division of Aventura Sailing that has the mission to introduce cruising sailors to the art, science and passion that is recreational yacht racing. Your journey will encompass the knowledge, experience and certification essential to transition from a cruising sailor to a confident recreational yacht racer.

Introduction to Keelboat Racing Clinic (Non-Spin)

The Introduction to Racing clinic prepares sailors with cruising experience with the knowledge, skills and initial experience to crew on a racing keelboat and consists of 20 hours of instruction. The Clinic is designed for the cruising sailor with Aventura Academy Advanced or ASA 103 or equivalent Certification and who are at least 18 years old and able to participate in this physical sport.

Included are 8 hours of lectures plus online self-learning so that graduates can meet the basic requirements of crew for a recreational non-spinnaker keelboat race including: safety, rigging, starting, beating upwind, tacking, basic tuning and trimming, mark rounding, jibing, reaching, running and rules of the road. In addition, students exercise practical racing skills in 12 hours of on the water coached racing experience.

Introductory Racing Crew - Clinic Topics:

- Things to Know - before you Go Racing
- Your Preparation, understanding what needs to be done Pre-Start and the Starting Sequence
- Understanding race modes and your job when Beating Upwind, Reaching & Running
- The importance of Mark Rounding and Finishing maneuvers

Pre-requisites: Aventura Advanced or ASA 103 or equivalent.

Competent Racing Crew Clinic (Non-Spin)

The Competent Racing Crew clinic aims to prepare Introductory Crew with basic racing experience with the knowledge, skills and initial experience to be a Competent crew member on a race keelboat. The Clinic consists of 20 hours of instruction. The Clinic is designed as a follow on to the Introduction to Racing Clinic or equivalent.

Included are 8 hours of lectures plus online self-learning so that graduates can meet the requirements of competent crew for competitive non-spinnaker keelboat racing: including: safety, rigging, starting, tacking, basic tuning and trimming, mark rounding, jibing, reaching, running, rules of the road. In addition, students exercise practical racing skills in 12 hours of on the water coached racing

experience.

Competent Crew - Clinic Topics:

- Things a Competent Crew Should Know - before you Go Racing
- Taking a lead role in Race Preparation, Pre-Start and Starting
- Optimizing performance Beating Upwind, Reaching & Running
- Optimized Mark Rounding & Finishing

Pre-requisites: Introduction to Keelboat Racing Clinic and a minimum of 10 races experience.

Racing Skipper & Tactician Clinic (Non-Spin)

The Racing Skipper & Tactician clinic aims to prepare Competent Crew with solid racing experience with the knowledge, skills and initial experience to be a Skipper or Tactician on a racing keelboat. The Clinic consists of 20 hours of instruction designed as a follow on to the Competent Racing Crew qualification or equivalent.

Included are 8 hours of lectures plus online self-learning so that graduates can meet the requirements of Skipper or Tactician for competitive non-spinnaker keelboat racing: including: safety, rigging, starting, tacking, tuning and trimming, mark rounding, jibing, reaching, running, rules of the road. In addition, students exercise practical racing skills in 12 hours of on the water coached racing experience aboard performance racing keelboats boats.

Racing Skipper & Tactician Clinic Topics:

- Things a Skipper Needs to Know - before taking the Boat and Crew Racing
- Race Preparation before the race day, and on race morning, Pre-Start Procedures and Starting maneuvers and tactics
- Beating, Reaching & Running – performance, conditions, maneuvers & tactics
- Competitive Mark Rounding & Finishing Tactics, Techniques

Pre-requisites: Competent Racing Crew Clinic and a minimum of 15 races experience.

Clinics provide the advanced learning, skills and experience to help you advance on your racing journey. Advanced follow-on clinics:

- Racing with a Symmetrical Spinnaker
- Racing with an Asymmetrical Spinnaker
- Coastal Racing Experience, Navigation, Weather & Tactics
